Approval of Last Meeting Minutes

Snow Plowing

Old Business

Automatic Association Dues Withdrawal

Board voted unanimously to start an Automatic Association Dues withdrawal (ACH) program. This will make it so all homeowners can have their dues payment automatically withdrawn from their bank account to the Meadow Creek bank account. The details on this will be sent to the owners by Vail Management Company

New Business

• Trash/Recycle

 Board unanimously approved adding an additional pick up for all recycling bins. VMC will call in additional pick-ups for trash dumpsters, when requested.

• C4 Request for Remodel

 Board unanimously approved C4's remodel with the requirement that the owner obtain all permits required for the remodel, which include, electrical, plumbing and building. These permits must be posted outside of the unit during the remodel.

M1 Hot Tub & Parking

- It was brought to VMC's attention that the tenants in M1 have a portable hot tub on their deck. The rules and regulations mention that hot tubs are only allowed with the approval by the board.
- O VMC has contacted the tenants and requested to have it removed or it would be physically removed by VMC. VMC has also received multiple complaints about M1 tenants parking in other unit's assigned spaces. VMC has reached out to the tenants to advise them of their parking violations. If the parking issues continue, VMC will be booting/towing the tenant's vehicles when they are uncompliant with the parking rules and regulations.
